geographic....political entity....(Rome and Athens) national states and cultural arena based on the individual WW I and II.......... never again: values and principles

Cultural barriers/identity individual, regional and national level, "united in diversity":

Globalization/regional actors global actors, global challenges, global answers

Problem: EU system based on individual rights but global actor (see comparable studies on culture and economic growth)

Solution: political honesty and constant dialogue, multiple identities

before and after Lisbon... the EU diplomatic service economic and cooperation instruments to soft power: cultural diplomacy, cultural relations

Cultural barriers/identity

peace needs trust – overcome cultural barriers, people to people, 3 sectors

Paradox: cultural diversity better understood in external than internal policy
